The Position

- Developing and/or implementing economic development strategies & workplans that grow the City's existing industry and business base, attract new businesses to the City, and support the activities of other City colleagues and departments while achieving City Council defined goals;
- Sharing ideas and developing economic development concepts with the Department Director and colleagues;
- Being part of the Department's leadership team and engaging in discussions about continuously improving the culture and work environment of the entire team.

- Will support the professional development of their colleagues and work to improve the City's economic development programs and activities;

- Can steward key economic development projects in the City's central business district and areas targeted for redevelopment.

Fairfield's Community Development Team

The Fairfield Community Development Department is made up of the Planning Division, Building and Safety Division, and the Economic Development team. The Department is in an exciting moment of change and innovation, which includes enacting a new economic development workplan, adopting a new General Plan at the end of 2024, on boarding a new platform for permitting and project management, and reorganizing the Department's procedures & workflows to improve the City's development processes. Additionally, the Department is engaged in a culture and communications initiative with the goal of continuous improvement towards sustaining a strong team environment and developing a shared set of professional cultural values.
