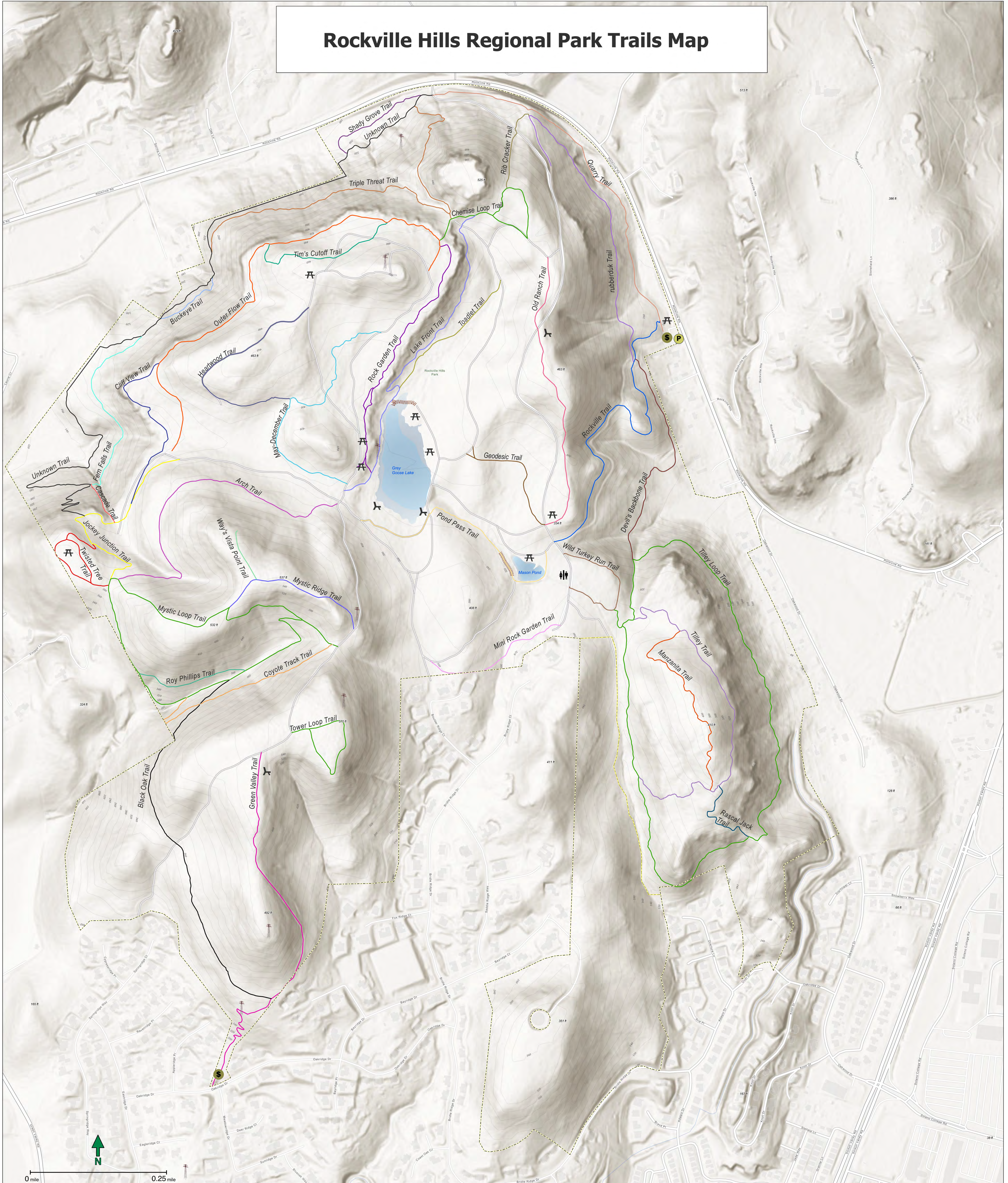

Rockville Trail Difficulty Guide

- Slight elevation changes**
 - May have uneven ground, small rocks, and ruts on trail
- Moderate elevation changes**
 - Will have areas of loose and uneven ground, occasional large rocks, and ruts on trail
- Significant elevation changes**
 - Mostly loose and uneven ground, numerous large rocks, boulders, and ruts on trail
- Extreme elevation changes**
 - Challenging obstacles: loose and extremely uneven ground, large rocks, boulders, stumps, ruts, steep climbs, and drops

BE RESPONSIBLE

Hiking, mountain biking, and trail running are risky activities. Minimize risk by using these guidelines:

- Watch the Weather**: Check the weather forecast before you hike.
- Dress Appropriately**: Wear the proper shoes, clothing, and head covering.
- Bring Water**: Hydrate before you go. Carry plenty of water - more than you think you need.
- Keep in Contact**: Carry a mobile phone.
- Be Mindful of Wildlife**: Take care not to disturb wildlife you may encounter on trails.
- Team Up**: Hike with others. If hiking alone, let someone know the location of your hike.
- Don't Trailblaze**: Please stay on signed trails only.
