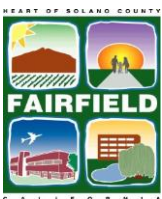


Street Name Sign Checklist and Requirements

This document represents general requirements for the submittal of street name signs. Once the street name sign submittal is approved, the City will submit a copy of the approved proofs to the contactor as well as the appropriate inspector. This list does not preclude the City from requesting additional information if deemed necessary (09/17/2018 V1)

General Requirements for Street Name Signs

- General** – Refer to *Section 20: Signs* and Standard Detail *T21* in 2017 Standard Specifications & Details
- Materials** – All street name signs shall have the following:
 - 0.125 gauge aluminum sign panel
 - 3M Diamond Grade DG3 (ASTM Type XI) reflective background or approved equal
 - Lettering shall be 3M Electrocut Film Series 1170 or approved equal **OR** screen printed with 3M 8801 Series translucent ink
 - 3M Anti-Graffiti Guard Series 1160 or approved equal
 - Double sided
- Dimensions** – All street name signs shall have the following dimensions:
 - 9" vertical panel
 - 24" minimum – 48" maximum width at 6" increments (length will vary based upon street name)
 - The street name legend shall be 6" upper case and 4 1/2" lower case
 - The street type suffix shall be 3" upper case
 - The block numbering shall be 3"
 - 1/4" white outside border
- Type Face** – All street name signs shall have Highway Gothic Series "C" with minimum 1/2" spacing
 - If the street name sign exceeds 48", Highway Gothic Series "B" may be used
- Submittal and City Review.** All street name sign proposals require review and approval from the following departments. Applicants will be required to reach out to each department for approval.
