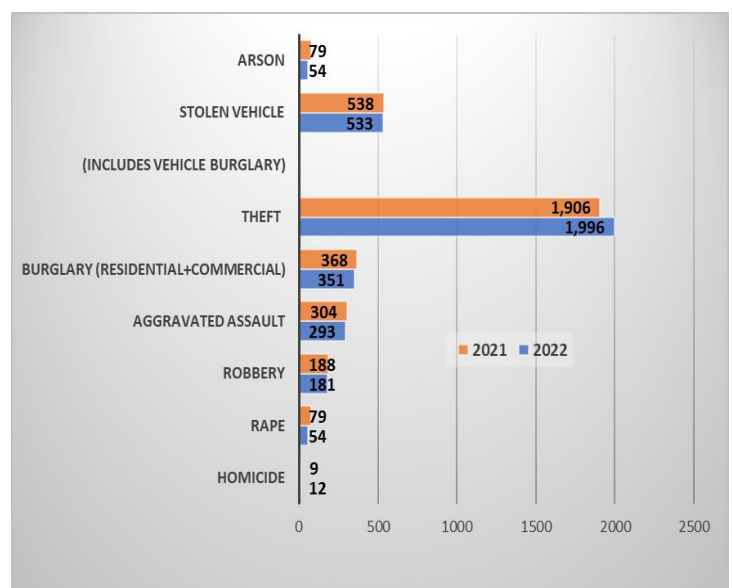
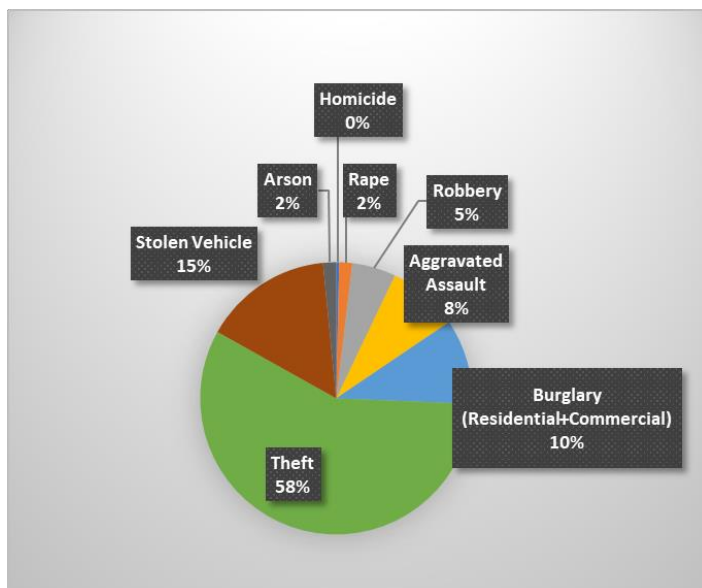

- Crime rate is currently **29.02** per 1,000 based on estimated population of 119,705
- Total part 1 crime increased +0.09%
- Violent crime decreased -7%
 - Homicide increased +33%
 - Rape decreased -32%
 - Robbery decreased -4%
 - Aggravated Assault decreased -4%
- Total property crime increased +2%
 - Burglary decreased -5%
 - Theft increased +5%
 - Stolen Vehicles decreased -0.9%
 - Arson decreased -32%
