Solano County Microbusiness Grant

application deadline extended!

Submit by 5:00pm, May 17th

Apply Now! Time is running out for our business owners to apply for the Solano County Microbusiness Grant. The \$2,500 California COVID-19 relief grant is specifically targeted to microbusinesses that have been open and operating since 2019 and had a 2019 business gross revenue of \$50,000 or less. This grant program has been established by Solano County, the Workforce Development Board (WDB) of Solano County, and the Solano-Napa Small Business Development Center.

A business may qualify for the Solano Microbusiness COVID-19 Relief \$2,500 grant if it meets all criteria, including the following:

- 1. Located in Solano County
- 2. In business since Dec. 2019 or earlier
- 3. Made less than \$50,000 in gross revenue in 2019
- 4. Currently open and operating
- 5. Business is currently the owner's primary source of income
- 6. Have 0 to 5 full-time equivalent employees
- 7. Did not receive a CA Relief Grant through Lendistry
