## ENCROACHMENT PERMIT CHECKLIST FOR DUMPSTERS/STORAGE CONTAINERS

Effective April 1, 2023

The permit is a one-page document issued over the Public Works front counter (located at City Hall, 1000 Webster Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor). The permit shall identify requirements for the placement of dumpster or storage container on public right-of-way and the person who will be responsible for them. *In order to obtain an encroachment permit, the following additional information must be provided*:

- □ **PLAN**: A Plan showing the locations of the dumpster in relation to the project location and the public street. Include street names and appropriate addresses.
- □ **FEES**: An Encroachment Permit Application Fee and Inspection Fees will be charged for each permit. Refer to the Encroachment Permit Fee chart for "placing a dumpster. storage unit, or signs."
- □ **INSURANCE:** Applicants wishing to place dumpster(s) within the public right-of-way shall provide the following prior to issuance of the permit:
  - 1. <u>Certificate of Insurance</u>- summarizing the Business Owner's or homeowner's insurance coverage, including Liability Insurance in the amount of \$250,000. *Note: Insurance Provider must have a minimum BEST rating of "A"*.

## Special requirements:

- 1. Reflectorized delineators or barricades shall be placed on either end of the dumpster or storage container since they are an obstruction within the roadway.
- 2. The encroachment permit can be revoked or suspended if Permittee does not comply with all requirements and conditions.
- 3. The Permittee shall call the Public Works Inspection Line, at 707-428-7558, at least 24 hours in advance to schedule an inspection prior to the placement of a dumpster or storage container, *and* after it has been removed.
